MATCH DETAILS

The Australian's second encounter was against Canada at Teddington Cricket Club, south-west of London on the edge of Bushy Park and close to the famous Hampton Court Palace. The team was: Lanigan[c] Budden, Bulger, Davis, Drescher, Harrison, Lyon, Preston, Riley, Southall, White and Wijeratne.

Tight and accurate bowling saw the dismissals of Budden [15], Lyon [12] and Drescher [12] in the first 15 overs. 3 for 66 at the first drinks break. Harrison fell after drinks, so consolidation was needed from Lanigan and Wijeratne. The score was 4/69 off 18 overs.



The Canadian bowlers bowled straight, minimising boundary balls. The score reached 4/103 at the 25 over mark. Lanigan was eventually caught and bowled in the 28th over, leaving Australia 5/113 as Davis came to the wicket. Australia reached 6/167 with 7 overs to go, with Wijeratne 66 not out; after 40, 6/172 and looking for quick runs. A fruitful seventh wicket partnership between Wijeratne and White progressed the total to 211 after 45 overs with Wijeratne not out 92 off 97 balls [113 minutes, 12 x 4's].

It was a brisk start by Canada, who posted 45 for the first wicket. George Preston took the first wicket by getting one under the opener's bat. A run out followed, and Canada were 2/47. Straight away there was an LBW to Mike Riley, and the score was 3/47. Then Simon Lyon caught one at short mid off and Canada slumped to 4/47 at drinks. Riley bowled his 9 overs straight through to take 1/20.

There were no wickets and 47 runs in the next 15 overs, and Canada reached 4/90. Preston took 2 for 31 off his 9 overs. The temperature hovering in the early 30's saw all players grit their teeth to get through the final 15 overs.

Finally there was a run out at the bowler's end – Lanigan returned to White who crawled to the stumps to affect the dismissal. The Canadians were 5/105 in the 34th over. Robert White bowled Johnson in his last over and finished with 1 for 31 from his 9 overs.



Multiple dismissals by Davis, including the top scorer Ravi Sathasivam for 52 and Canada were dismissed for 156 after 43 overs, Davis finishing with 4 for 36.

Fine batting by Wijeratne held the Australian batting innings together. A good bowling performance in trying conditions saw the Australians winners by 55 runs
